This function returns the average answer of the answers given question ID across all completed surveys in real time.

%%query allows you to optionally specify a query string variable to filter by. Like this: "urlvar\_department=support" will return the average value for this question for respondents with the department "support".

## Example

This example simply gets the average value for the first question of the survey and displays it.
