Legacy Custom Scripting Language Deprecation Plans

- 1. New accounts (created after October 29, 2018) will only have the option to use Lua in scripts.
- 2. As of October 29, 2018 Custom Scripting Actions will default to Lua as the scripting type in the Custom Scripting Action for accounts created before this date. You will be able to switch to the Legacy Custom Scripting; though we highly encourage using Lua.
- 3. In the long term, Legacy Custom Scripting Actions will be switched to read-only. The exact date on this is to be determined; we will send notifications well ahead of time.

This function returns the option sku for the selected answer. For multi-select questions will return an array.

## Example

In this example, we return the option sku of a single-select question (ID 7) and a multiple-select question using sgapiGetQuestionOptionSelected() and sgapiPrint\_R().

%%output .= sgapiGetQuestionOptionSelected(7);
%%output .= sgapiPrint_R (sgapiGetQuestionOptionSelected(8));
```

Output for a single select question would be an option sku, for example, 10008.

Output for a multi-select question would be an array of option skus, for example,  $4Array([0] \Rightarrow 10012[1] \Rightarrow 10013)$ 

Note: To output an array the  $sgapiPrint_R$  function must be used.
