Legacy Custom Scripting Language Deprecation Plans

- 1. New accounts (created after October 29, 2018) will only have the option to use Lua in scripts.
- 2. As of October 29, 2018 Custom Scripting Actions will default to Lua as the scripting type in the Custom Scripting Action for accounts created before this date. You will be able to switch to the Legacy Custom Scripting; though we highly encourage using Lua.
- 3. In the long term, Legacy Custom Scripting Actions will be switched to read-only. The exact date on this is to be determined; we will send notifications well ahead of time.

This function returns the number of responses (completes) that have been collected for the current survey. It takes an optional %%urlname parameter that filters by a URL variable. %%name should be in the format of: "urlvar_VariableName=Value".

Example

In this example, we return the number of completed responses with the url variable "location=Denver". URL variable needs to be configured manually, either through the link creation menu, email campaign system, or some other means.
